Summary:

The TSL Grant is a Federal Grant awarded to APSRC for promoting educator effectiveness in rural Arkansas schools through a Human Capital Management System and professional development aligned to academic achievement data and teacher defined competencies.

Grant goals include an emphasis on systems change that focuses on teacher level decision making that enhances capacity for increasing the academic growth and performance of students. Systematic professional development rooted in evidence-based practice is also a key component of the grant capacity building process. The grant is undergirded by a scaffold of support-defined incentives that form the Human Capital Management System and the Logic Model. Teacher recruitment and retention strategies serve to ensure sustainability of grant outcomes.

The grant is currently awarded for a three-year period with year two and three funding contingent on achieving the defined year one goals.

Qualifications:

- Experience with Federal grants/programs preferred.
- Must be able to travel statewide.
- Experience with personnel management, academic coaching, fiscal oversight, and teacher evaluation is preferred.
- Understanding of student achievement, growth data and its analysis and relationship to instructional techniques and outcomes is strongly preferred.
